Contractor agrees to furnish all labor, materials, equipment, and services necessary to perform electrical work in accordance with the project documents, plans, specifications, and applicable codes and standards, including but not limited to installation, repair, maintenance, and inspection of electrical systems at the project location.

## Term and Termination:

This Agreement shall commence upon execution and continue until completion of the Scope of Work unless terminated earlier in accordance with this Agreement. Either party may terminate this Agreement upon written notice if the other party materially breaches any provision and fails to cure within a reasonable time. Upon termination, Client shall pay Contractor for all work performed up to the date of termination.

## Permits and Compliance:

Contractor shall obtain and pay for all necessary permits, licenses, and inspections required by local, state, and federal authorities to perform the Scope of Work. Contractor shall perform all work in compliance with applicable laws, codes, regulations, and standards, including the National Electrical Code (NEC) and OSHA requirements.

## Warranties and Representations:

Contractor warrants that all work will be performed in a professional and workmanlike manner and in accordance with industry standards. Contractor warrants materials and equipment to be new unless otherwise specified and free from defects for a period of one year from completion. This warranty is exclusive and in lieu of all other warranties, express or implied.

## Indemnification and Insurance:

Contractor shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Client and its agents from any claims, damages, liabilities, and expenses arising from Contractor's negligence or willful misconduct. Contractor shall maintain insurance coverage including general liability, workers' compensation, and automotive liability in amounts satisfactory to Client and shall provide certificates of insurance upon request.

**Change Orders:**

Any changes to the Scope of Work, contract price, or schedule must be made in writing and signed by both parties as a Change Order. Contractor shall not be obligated to perform any extra work without a signed Change Order.

**Dispute Resolution:**

Any disputes arising under or related to this Agreement shall be resolved first by good faith negotiations between the parties. If unresolved, disputes shall be submitted to binding arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association, held in the jurisdiction where the project is located.

**Governing Law and Venue:**

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State in which the project is located, without regard to its conflict of laws principles. Venue for any legal action arising out of this Agreement shall be exclusively in the state or federal courts located in the county of the project.

**Entire Agreement and Amendments:**

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between Contractor and Client and supersedes all prior negotiations and agreements, whether written or oral. Any amendments or modifications must be in writing and signed by both parties.

**Force Majeure:**

Neither party shall be liable for any delays or failures in performance caused by events beyond their reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, natural disasters, acts of government, labor disputes, or other unforeseen circumstances.
