Use and Maintenance:

Lessee agrees to use the Equipment in a careful and proper manner and comply with all applicable laws and regulations. Lessee shall maintain the Equipment in good condition and immediately notify Lessor of any damage, malfunction, or loss. Lessee shall be responsible for any damage resulting from misuse, neglect, or unauthorized modification.

Liability and Insurance:

Lessee assumes all risk of loss, damage, or injury arising from use or possession of the Equipment. Lessee shall maintain adequate insurance coverage during the rental term, naming Lessor as an additional insured, and provide proof of such insurance upon request. Lessor shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, or consequential damages arising

out of or related to this Agreement.

Indemnification:

Lessee agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Lessor, its agents, employees, and affiliates from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities, costs, and expenses arising out of Lessee's use, operation, or possession of the Equipment, including attorney's fees and costs.

Default and Remedies:

If Lessee fails to pay rental fees or otherwise breaches this Agreement, Lessor may terminate this Agreement immediately, repossess the Equipment, and pursue all available legal remedies. Lessee shall be responsible for all costs of collection, including reasonable attorney's fees.

Return of Equipment:

Lessee shall return the Equipment to Lessor at the agreed location in the same condition as received, ordinary wear and tear excepted, on or before the end of the Rental Period. Failure to return timely shall result in additional charges and potential legal action.

Governing Law and Venue:

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of _____, without regard to its conflict-of-law principles. The parties consent to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the state or federal courts located in _____ County, _____.

Entire Agreement and Amendments:

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, understandings, and agreements. Any amendments or modifications must be in writing and signed by both parties.

Severability:

If any provision of this Agreement is found to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Waiver:

The failure of either party to enforce any provision of this Agreement shall not be deemed a waiver of such provision or the right to enforce it.

Notices:

All notices shall be in writing and deemed effectively given when delivered personally, by certified mail return receipt requested, nationally recognized overnight courier, or by electronic means with confirmation of receipt, to the addresses

set forth above or such other address as a party may designate by notice.
