All concepts, drawings, specifications, and related materials prepared by the Designer are the Designer's intellectual property and shall not be used for other projects without Designer's consent. Upon full payment, the Client is granted a license to use the materials for the intended project.

Limitation of Liability:

The Designer shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, consequential, or punitive damages arising out of or related to the services or this Agreement. The Designer's total liability shall not exceed the amount paid by the Client under this Agreement.

Governing Law and Dispute Resolution:

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of _____, without regard to conflict of law principles. Any dispute arising under this Agreement shall be resolved through mediation or binding arbitration in _____ County, _____ State, unless otherwise agreed.
