**1. Scope of Services**

The Lance Provider agrees to provide the services described in this Contract to the Client subject to the terms and conditions herein. The services shall be performed professionally and in accordance with industry standards.

**2. Term and Termination**

Either party may terminate this Contract upon written notice to the other party for material breach that remains uncured after ten (10) calendar days' notice.

**3. Compensation**

The Client agrees to pay the Lance Provider the amount set forth above according to the payment schedule. All payments shall be made in United States Dollars and are due according to the agreed schedule without offset or deduction.

**4. Confidentiality**

Each party acknowledges that confidential information may be disclosed pursuant to this Contract. Both parties agree to maintain all such information confidential and to use it solely for the purposes of performing obligations under this Contract.

**5. Independent Contractor**

The Lance Provider is an independent contractor and nothing in this Contract shall be construed to create a partnership, joint venture, or employer-employee relationship between the parties.

**6. Liability and Indemnification**

The Lance Provider shall indemnify and hold harmless the Client from and against any claims, damages, liabilities, and

expenses arising out of the Provider's negligence or willful misconduct. The Client's liability shall be limited to direct damages and shall exclude consequential damages.

#### **7. Governing Law and Dispute Resolution**

This Contract shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the United States and the State applicable to the Client's principal place of business without regard to conflict of law principles. Any disputes arising hereunder shall be resolved by binding arbitration in accordance with the rules of a recognized arbitration institution agreed upon by the parties.

#### **8. Force Majeure**

Neither party shall be liable for delays or failure to perform due to causes beyond their reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, natural disasters, government actions, or labor disputes.

#### **9. Notices**

All notices under this Contract shall be in writing and delivered by hand, certified mail, reputable courier, or electronic communication with confirmation to the addresses provided herein.

#### **10. Entire Agreement**

This Contract constitutes the entire agreement between the parties regarding its subject matter and supersedes all prior agreements, understandings, and negotiations, whether written or oral.

#### **11. Amendments**

Any amendment or modification to this Contract must be in writing and signed by authorized representatives of both parties.

#### **12. Severability**

If any provision of this Contract is found to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

#### **13. Waiver**

Failure or delay of either party to enforce any right or provision of this Contract shall not constitute a waiver of such right or provision.

#### **14. Assignment**

Neither party may assign their rights or obligations under this Contract without the prior written consent of the other party.

#### **15. Compliance with Laws**

Both parties agree to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and ordinances in the performance of their obligations under this Contract.

#### **16. Insurance**

The Lance Provider shall maintain adequate insurance coverage appropriate to the services provided and shall provide certificates of insurance upon request.

#### **17. Non-Solicitation**

During the term of this Contract and for twelve (12) months thereafter, the Client agrees not to solicit or hire employees or contractors of the Lance Provider without prior written consent.

#### **18. Intellectual Property**

All intellectual property developed or delivered in connection with this Contract shall remain the property of the Lance Provider unless otherwise agreed in writing.

**19. Counterparts**

This Contract may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument.
