4. CANCELLATION AND POSTPONEMENT:

Either party may cancel the performance upon written notice to the other party. If the Performer cancels, any deposit paid shall be refunded to the Presenter. If the Presenter cancels less than ____ days before the performance, the deposit shall be forfeited and the Performer shall be entitled to the full fee. Postponement of the performance date requires mutual written agreement and may be subject to additional fees.

5. PERFORMANCE STANDARDS AND CONDUCT:

Performer agrees to arrive on time, be prepared to perform, and deliver a professional musical performance consistent with industry standards. Performer shall comply with all venue rules and regulations and shall conduct themselves in a manner that does not harm the reputation of Presenter or the venue.

6. PROMOTION AND RECORDING:

Presenter may use Performer's name and likeness solely for the purpose of advertising and promoting the performance. Any audio or video recording of the performance requires prior written consent from the Performer.

7. LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION:

Each party agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the other party from and against any claims, liabilities, damages, or expenses arising out of negligence or willful misconduct related to this Agreement. Performer is responsible for their own equipment and personal property.

8. FORCE MAJEURE:

Neither party shall be held liable for failure or delay in performance due to causes beyond their reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, government actions, labor disputes, or other unforeseen events.

9. GOVERNING LAW AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION:

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of _____, without regard to conflict-of-law principles. Any disputes arising out of or related to this Agreement shall be resolved first through good faith negotiation between the parties. If unresolved, disputes shall be submitted to mediation or binding arbitration in _____ County, _____.

10. ENTIRE AGREEMENT; AMENDMENTS:

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, agreements, or understandings whether written or oral. Any amendments or modifications must be in writing and signed by both parties.

11. SEVERABILITY:

If any provision of this Agreement is determined to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

12. NOTICES:

All notices under this Agreement shall be in writing and delivered personally, by certified mail, or by nationally recognized overnight courier to the addresses listed above or such other address as a party may designate.
